1-day course

Aim

Over 15,000 organisations are certified to ISO4001 in the UK, with many implementing the standard to meet client requirements or to support tenders.

This course provides tools and workshops to help understand how the standard operates and be implemented to get the best out of the standard.

Objectives

- *To equip participants with an understanding of ISO 14001:2015 and its requirements*
- *To understand how the management system can support the environmental performance of the organisation*
- *To encourage participants to take the opportunity to re-invigorate their EMS.*
